

TSOGOLO LA ANA ORGANISATION

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A REPORT ON EDUCATION BURSARY FOR 2022 TO 2023 SCHOOL YEAR

INTRODUCTION

Tsogolo la Ana organisation is a local Malawian Non-Governmental organization that works with children towards promoting their rights and improving the livelihood of their families. With assistance from Open Hearts of Germany the Organization provides education bursary to the underprivileged children of Tsogolo la Ana Community Day secondary in Mpemba, Blantyre Rural. 40 students benefitted from this bursary.

IDENTIFICATION OF FORM 1 STUDENTS

- 10 new students (4 girls, 6 boys) were selected to be among the beneficiaries of the education bursary.
- A meeting with the parents of the children together with the beneficiaries was held to aware them about the education bursary. An agreement form was signed by the child, parent, TAO and head teacher agreeing on the responsibilities of each party.
- Every child received a pair of school uniform, a pair of school shoes, a school bag, a mathematical set of instrument, 10 notebooks, 2 pens and a scientific calculator.

SCHOOL FEES

• School fees for 40 students for 1st, 2nd and 3rd terms was paid.

EXAMINATION FEES

- Examination fees for 10 students who sat for Junior Certificate of Education was paid to Malawi National Examinations Board (MANEB).
- Examination fees for 10 students who sat for Malawi School Certificate of Examination (MSCE).

SCHOOL MATERIALS FIRST TERM

- Each of the 40 students writing materials as follows: 10 exercise books, 2 ball point pens, mathematical instrument.
- Form 3 students received a school uniform as the one that is received at form 1 becomes small.

SECOND TERM

 Each of the 40 students received the following: 10 exercise books and 2 ball point pens.

THIRD TERM

• Each of the 40 student received 10 exercise books and 2 pens.

END OF TERM RESULTS

FORM 1 THIRD TERM

• All the 10students (5girls, 5 boys) passed the examinations representing 100% pass rate.

FORM 2

THIRD TERM

Students write the national examinations and the results were as follows:

• 10 students (6 girls, 4 boys) who sat for Junior Certificate Examinations passed making it 100% pass rate.

FORM 3

THIRD TERM

• 3 students passed and 7 students failed representing 30 % pass rate.

FORM 4 THIRD TERM

 Out of 10 students who sat for national examinations, M.S.C.E, 7 students passed and 3 students failed representing 70% pass rate.

ACHIEVEMENT

- There is an improvement in the pass rate of the student as 30 out of 40 students passed the end of year examinations representing 75 % pass rate. The improvement has come after asking the learners to work hard and compete with each other in order for them to have an continue having an opportunity of being on the bursary.
- Most of the parents expressed gratitude with this initiating saying that they can now see that their children are studying at home and their results have really improved. This initiative will also help to produce good results at National examinations.
